

Valley Veterinary Clinic Summer Internship 2024

Valley Veterinary Clinic in Seymour, WI offers a dairy veterinary internship each summer for veterinary students finishing their first or second year. The internship is a broad-based food animal program that includes training in individual animal medicine and herd production medicine for dairy cattle. VVC currently has 17 veterinarians practicing dairy production medicine in a broad area of northeastern Wisconsin.

The intern will work closely with VVC veterinarians that will provide supervision and training in dairy cattle medicine, surgery, herd health, and production medicine. The large majority of this program will be spent in the field.

As part of the training, the intern would have the opportunity to participate in the following specialty areas: ET/IVF services, youngstock services, milk quality services, personnel services, and data analysis. Additionally, duties will include helping with some nighttime emergencies and work around the clinic. The intern will be responsible for a project due at the end of the internship. The project will be planned in conjunction with the selected applicant, and is intended to be a benefit both to the student and to VVC clientele.

The length of the internship is 10 weeks. The internship is a paid position and housing will be included. To apply please submit your cover letter, resume, and contact information for 3 references to bgrandaw@vvcvets.com. In your cover letter please address what areas of dairy veterinary medicine most interest you and what you hope to get out of this internship. The deadline for applying is December 3, 2023. Interviews will be conducted in December and applicants will be notified in January.
