Sharps Disposal



Valley Veterinary Clinic can not accept any used sharps (needles), please see the following steps and website on recycling sharps. Thank you!

1

Purchasing a sharps container is recommended for storing used needles, but you can also use a strong plastic container with a lid if need be. Do not use soda or water bottles!

Please contact the clinic, if you'd like to purchase a sharps container

2

When the container is 3/4 full, put the lid on. If it's not a sharps container, you will need to seal it with duct tape and label with "Do Not Recycle"

3

Bring the sharps container to your nearest disposal location. Please see this website for locations: www.safeneedledisposal.org/states/wisconsin
